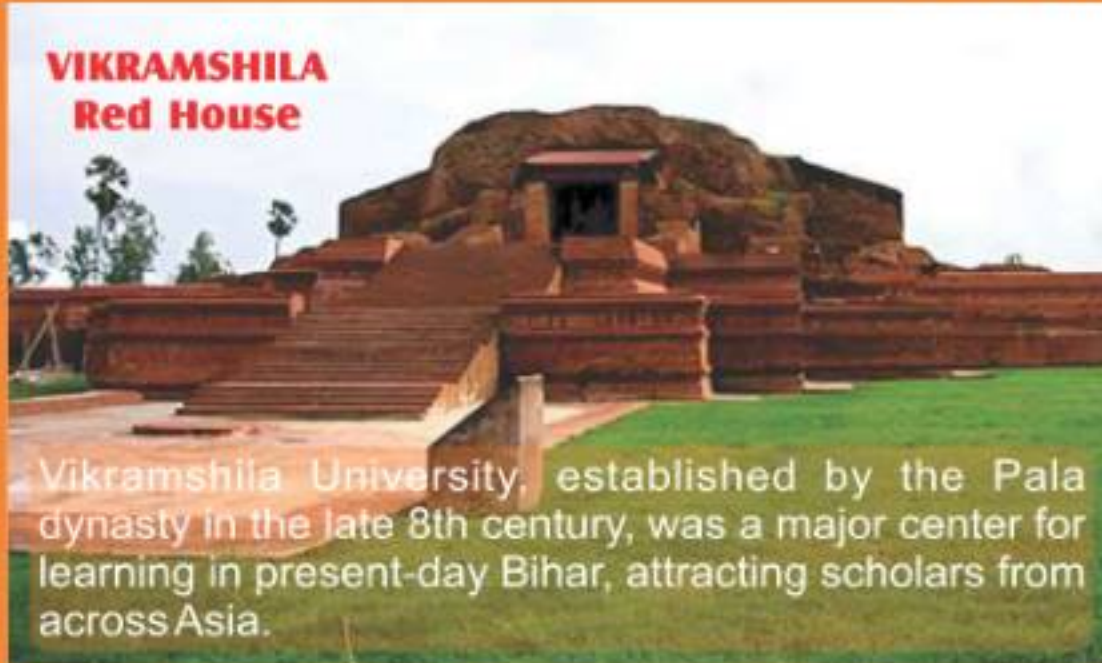

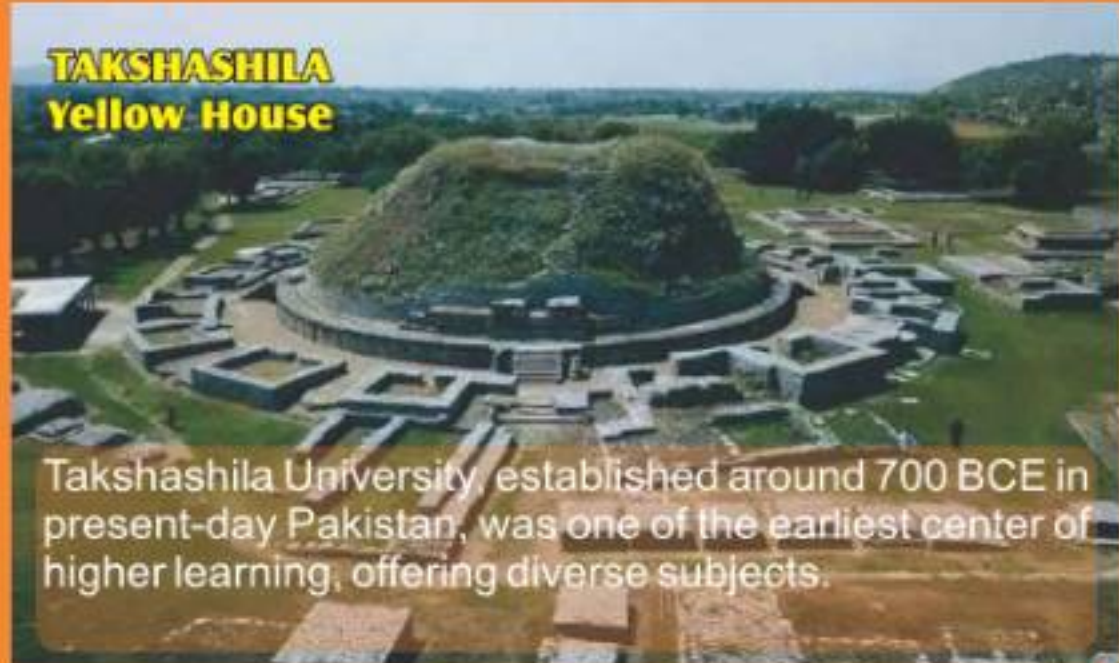
## ANCIENT CENTERS OF LEARNING IN INDIA OUR SCHOOL HOUSES

### VIKRAMSHILA Red House



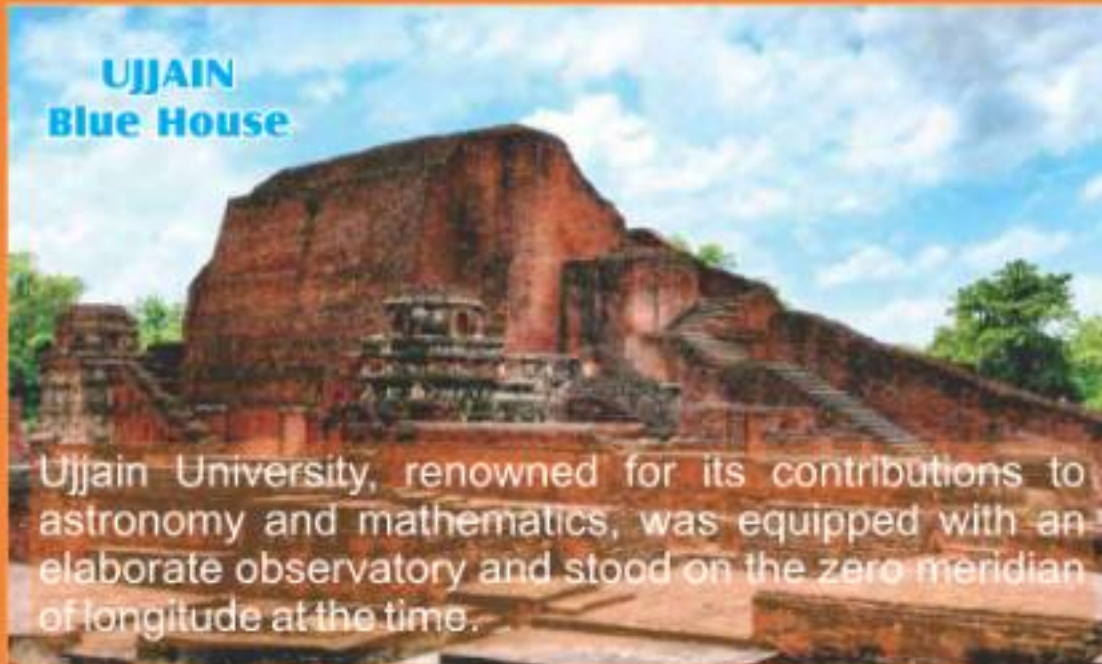
Vikramshila University, established by the Pala dynasty in the late 8th century, was a major center for learning in present-day Bihar, attracting scholars from across Asia.

### TAKSHASHILA Yellow House



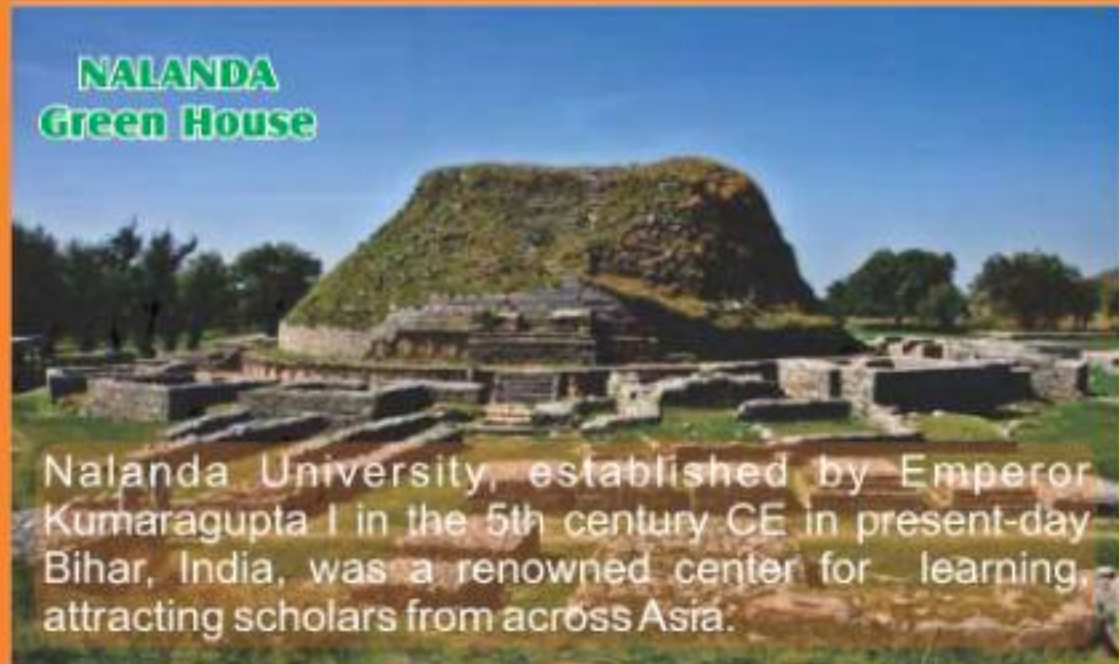
Takshashila University, established around 700 BCE in present-day Pakistan, was one of the earliest center of higher learning, offering diverse subjects.

### UJJAIN Blue House



Ujjain University, renowned for its contributions to astronomy and mathematics, was equipped with an elaborate observatory and stood on the zero meridian of longitude at the time.

### NALANDA Green House



Nalanda University, established by Emperor Kumaragupta I in the 5th century CE in present-day Bihar, India, was a renowned center for learning, attracting scholars from across Asia.
